This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 76 dated 1.5.2017 under Section 22/61 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at P.S. Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had faced the trial and throughout the trial he has not misused the concession of bail. He further states that only on one occasion he could not appear i.e. on 8.3.2019 because on 11.2.2019 the petitioner had inadvertently noted down the next date of hearing as 9.3.2019 whereas it was 8.3.2019.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Counsel for the petitioner has supplied a copy of the paper book to the learned DAG.

In my opinion, in case above statement is correct, then one lapse can be condoned.

In the circumstances, let the petitioner appear before the Court on 10.5.2019 and if it is correct that he has never misused the concession of bail during the trial the Court would release him on bail to its satisfaction on that date.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
