By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

On 16.05.2019, while dismissing the petition earlier filed by the petitioner, it had been observed by a coordinate Bench as follows:-

“Consequently, even while dismissing this petition, the trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conduct its entire evidence on or before 14.08.2019, subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal misc. application, if any, also stands dismissed.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in court an order passed by this court on 05.11.2019 in CRM-M-21611 of 2019, titled as **Sheru v. State of Punjab**, admitting the said co-accused of the petitioner to bail while noticing that against the present petitioner, Nirvail Singh, there were 6 other criminal cases pending.

That being so, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the

petitioner to approach the trial court in terms of the aforesaid order passed by a coordinate Bench on 16.05.2019.
