The categoric averments made in the petition are that the petitioner is in cultivating possession of land measuring 396 kanals situated on the Indo-Pak Border falling under Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of a Gate Pass having been issued to the petitioner by the B.S.F authorities at Annexure P-2, he is not being permitted to cultivate the land.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Commandant, 22nd Battalion, B.S.F Campus, Ram Tirath, P.O. Chhehrata, District Amritsar/respondent no.3 as regards his grievance along with all necessary and supporting documents to demonstrate the possessory rights on the land in question.

In the eventuality of any such application/representation being made, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
