The applicants are in jail in connection with Case Crime No. 220 of 2018, under Section 3/5/11 of Uttarakhand Cow Progeny (Protection) Act and Section 3/11 of Animal Cruelty (Prevention) Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali Roorkee, District Haridwar.

According to the F.I.R., on 19.06.2018, 400 kgs. beef was recovered from a *Gher* (extended courtyard) of coaccused, namely, Naushad. Applicants ran away from the scene of occurrence when they saw the police approaching them.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that co-accused, namely, Naushad has already been granted bail by this Court on 30.01.2019 in BA1 No. 211 of 2018. He submits that this is a case of parity, therefore, the applicants deserve to be enlarged on bail.

Learned Assistant Government Advocate fairly concedes that this is a case of parity.

Parity warrants that the applicants be also released on bail.

Accordingly, the bail application is allowed.

Let the applicants, namely, Rahman, Nizam and Rashid be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid offence on their executing a personal bond by each of them and furnishing two reliable sureties by each one of them, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
