This misc. application (MCRC No. 108 of 2020) has been filed by the applicant seeking following relief:

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to allow the present Misc. Application and grant some reasonable time to the applicant to surrender before the learned trial Court and further may graciously be pleased to direct the learned trial Court that if any bail application has been moved on behalf of the applicant the same may kindly be heard and decided on the same day itself in terms of the provisions contained under section 437 of Cr.P.C.; otherwise the applicant shall suffer irreparable loss and injury.”

Since criminal misc. application filed by the applicant was dismissed on merit, against which applicant had approached Hon'ble Supreme Court and, ultimately, his S.L.P. was also dismissed as withdrawn, therefore, this Court cannot pass any order on this application.

Accordingly, misc. application is dismissed.
