Heard Mr. Subhang Dobhal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms. Soniya Chawla, Advocate holding brief of Mr. Paresh Tripathi, learned counsel for the opposite party.

Petitioner filed WPSS No. 2110 of 2017, which was disposed of by writ court vide order dated 01.08.2017 with a direction to the Vice Chancellor of Hemvati Nandan Bahuguna Garhwal University to take decision on petitioner's representation regarding regularization of his service. Further direction was issued to the University to pay minimum of pay scale to the petitioner in terms of the law laid down in the case of State of Punjab & others Vs Jagjit Singh & others (civil Appeal No. 213 of 2013).

Today, a compliance affidavit has been filed in Court by learned counsel for the University/opposite party. Learned counsel for the opposite party relying upon annexure No. 1 to the response affidavit submits that after considering representation of the petitioner, an order has been passed by Registrar of the University on 08.10.2018 providing that claim of the petitioner for regularization would be considered only after framing of Cadre Recruitment Rules. It has further been provided in the said order that minimum of pay scale has been sanctioned to the petitioner. The compliance affidavit, filed by the counsel for the University in Court, is taken on record.

In view of the stand taken by opposite party in the response affidavit, this Court is of the considered opinion that no contempt is made out against the opposite party.

Accordingly, contempt petition is dismissed. Notice issued to the opposite party is hereby discharged.
