By means of the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking a direction from this Court directing the respondents to remove the gate installed by the respondent no.3 over the road which leads to Harilok Colony, Jwalapur, Haridwar and further to direct the respondents to remove the encroachment over the front portion of the commercial property of the petitioner.

In view of this Court, the petitioner has no remedy under the public law. These are not the matters which can be looked into in a writ petition as the dispute is purely private in nature.

Consequently, the writ petition stands dismissed.

It is made clear that the dismissal of the case will not prejudice the right of the petitioner in case he wishes to file a civil suit.
