The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:

“In the facts and circumstances of what has been stated hereinabove, it is most respectfully prayed that Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to-

- a) issue a writ of mandamus and / or certiorari or any other writ of like nature of direction to Consider of application for allotment of PCO /STD booth dated 26.08.2009 Under welfare scheme of weaker sections of society of poor / handicapped / schedule caste.*
- b) Any other or further relief which this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper looking to the circumstances of the case may please also be passed in favour of the petitioner and against the respondent after grant of*

prayer.”
