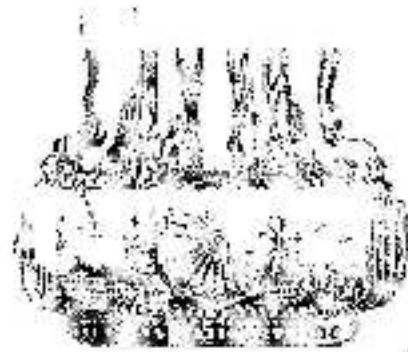
In view of the limited prayer addressed; the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to address a comprehensive representation to the respondents ventilating his grievances raised herein.

In case, a representation is so addressed within the aforesaid period, the respondents are directed to consider and decide the same by a reasoned and speaking order strictly in accordance with law and accordingly if the petitioner is entitled to receive the benefit, the same may be released thereafter within a period of sixty days from the date a certified copy of this order is presented.
