1. Petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.
2. F.I.R. No. 264/2019 was registered at Police Station Manoharpur district Jaipur for offence under Sections 354, 349, 511, 366 and 506 of I.P.C. and offence under Section 66 of Information Technology (Amended) Act, 2008.
3. It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that allegation in FIR is of preparing of video wherein name and address of the prosecutrix was asked.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
5. I have considered the contentions.
6. Considering the contentions put forth by counsel for the

petitioner, I deem it proper to allow the bail application.

7. This bail application is accordingly allowed and it is directed that accused petitioner shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac Only) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court and any court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

8. However it is made clear that if the petitioner repeats the offence, State would be free to move application for cancellation of bail before the concerned Court.

9. A copy of this order be sent to concerned SHO for recording this condition in the Village Crime Record Book so that in the event of petitioner's repeating offence, SHO can move the Court for cancellation of bail.
