1. Petitioner has filed this miscellaneous bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
2. F.I.R. No.128/2019 was registered at Police Station Aligarh, District Tonk, for offence under Sections 143, 341, 323 and 354 of I.P.C.
3. It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the earlier FIR was lodged by the petitioner party. It is also contended that there is cross-FIR. It is also contended that co-accused has been given benefit of anticipatory bail by co-ordinate Bench of this court.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
5. I have considered the contentions.
6. Considering the arguments put forth by counsel for the

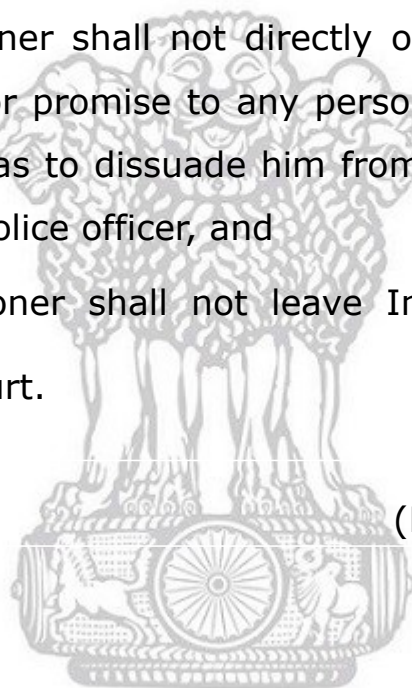
petitioner, I deem it proper to allow the anticipatory bail application.

7. The anticipatory bail application is allowed. The S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer, Police Station Aligarh, District Tonk, in F.I.R. No.128/2019 is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each to his satisfaction on the following conditions :-

- (i). that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii). that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
- (iii). that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
