Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents.

This writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondent no.2 to decide Mutation Case No. 154/16.1.2017(Angad Vs. Lakshuman), under section 34 of Land Revenue Act.

It has been stated that the mutation case was filed on 16.1.2017 under Section 34 of the Land Revenue Act by one Angad, who has no concern with the property of the late husband of the petitioner who was the owner of the Arazi No. 452-016, 616-028, 624Kha-016, 6252-049, 699gha-004, 690-020, 696-486, 972-472, 623-0.688 hectare. The petitioner has filed objection in that case. It is contended that the case is unnecessarily lingering in the Court below causing great harassment to the petitioner who is a widow.

From perusal of the order sheet that has been enclosed with this writ petition, it appears that the general dates are being fixed in the matter.

Without entering into the merits of the case, I direct the respondent no.2 to decide the said Mutation Case No. 154/16.1.2017(Angad Vs. Lakshman), under section 34 of Land Revenue Act, expeditiously and preferably within six months from the date of filing of a certified copy of this order after providing an opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
