Heard Mr.B.P.Sahu, learned senior counsel for the applicants as well as Mr.Devananda, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.1/writ petitioner.

By this application, the applicants are praying for vacation of the interim order 6.2.2020 passed in WP(C) No.98 of 2020 whereby it was directed that the respondent/writ petitioner may be allowed to appear before the Interview scheduled to be held on 7th and 8th of February, 2020 for the post of Assistant Professor (Physics). It was further directed that the result of the interview for the post of Assistant Professor (Physics) shall not be declared with the leave of this Court.

Mr.Devananda, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/writ petitioner submits that in terms of the interim order dated 6.2.2020 the respondent/writ petitioner had appeared in the interview for the post of Assistant Professor (Physics).

As the writ petitioner has already appeared in the interview for the post of Assistant Professor (Physics), this Court is of the considered opinion that the result for the post of Assistant Professor (Physics) should be declared and accordingly, the interim order dated 6.2.2020 passed in WP(C) No.98 of 2020 stands vacated.

It is further made clear that any appointment made to the post of Assistant Professor (Physics) shall be subject to the outcome of the main writ petition.

The misc case is, accordingly, allowed and disposed of.
