Heard Mr. J. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. R. Datta, learned P.P., appearing for the State-respondent.

This is an application filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for granting bail to the accused-petitioner who is evading arrest in connection with Melagrah P.S. Case No.2018/MLG 062(NDPS) under Sections 22(B)(ii)(C)/25/29 of the NDPS Act.

Learned P.P., has strongly opposed the bail application.

I have perused the case diary.

After hearing learned counsel appearing for the parties, in my opinion, it is a fit case to direct the petitioner to surrender before the learned Special Judge.

Following Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court cannot grant bail to the petitioner.

With the above observation and direction, the instant bail application stands dismissed.
