Heard the learned Advocates appearing for the parties.

Having considered the materials on record and keeping in mind the nature of allegations that the victim was a major lady at the time of cohabitation, we are of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary and this is a fit case to grant anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
