ORDER

01. The petitioner claimed to be an association of Medical & Surgical traders, dealing in supply of the medicines, machines and equipments to the Health & Medical education Department as well as various other departments of the then State of Jammu & Kashmir. The petitioner approached this Court praying for the following reliefs:-

“a) Quash the Government Order No. 428 HME of 2007 dated 03.07.2007 by virtue of which the Government has constituted the Provincial Purchase Committees for Jammu and Kashmir Divisions and restore the Central Purchase Committee constituted vide Government Order No. 813 HME of 2003 dated 22.07.2003.

b) To continue the process of establishing the J&K Health & Medical Education Supplies Corporation which had come into vide Government Order No. 1169 HME of 2003.”

02. Notice in the petition was issued on 07.12.2007. However, no interim direction was passed.

03. As the tender pertained to the year 2007 and liberty was given to the members of the petitioner-association to submit the tender documents in response to the NIT, if any, issued by the Jammu Provincial Purchase Committee. *Prima facie*, nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication. However, as none has appeared for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
