ORDER

CM No. 6998/2020

01. Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that because of the COVID-19 pandemic, he had not been able to get the Court fees to be annexed with the petition. He seeks some time to do the needful after the court re-opens.

02. The application is allowed. The applicants are permitted to submit the Court fees in the Registry in terms of Circular No. 16/GS dated 29.03.2020 issued by the High Court.

03. The application is disposed of accordingly.

04. The present petition has been filed praying for the following reliefs:

“a) Respondents to provide protection/security to the petitioners in the facts and circumstances of present case.

b) Quash and set aside FIR No. 293 of 2020, registered by Police Station Kathua for the commission of offence under Section 363 of Indian Penal Code.”

05. The petitioner No.2 is a minor. The petitioner No.1 claims that he is her next friend, hence, he presenting her cause before the Court.

06. The fact which is on record is that the petitioner No.1 is an accused in FIR No. 293/2020 dated 18.09.2020, registered at Police Station, Kathua for alleged abduction of the petitioner No. 2.

07. Keeping in view of the fact that the petitioner No.1 is an accused in FIR No. 293/2020, registered at Police Station, Kathua against him for abduction of the petitioner No.2, who is a minor girl, the petition filed by him claiming that he is her next friend cannot be entertained.

08. The same is accordingly dismissed.
