## <u>ORDER</u>

1. In view of Notification No. G.S.R. 267(E) dated 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 read with Notification No. G.S.R. 317(E) dated 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2020, issued by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel and Training), the jurisdiction to decide the *lis* regarding service disputes of the employees of the Union Territories of J&K, and Ladakh has been conferred upon the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT), Jammu Bench.
