According to petitioner, after competing and fulfilling all requirements in tendering process, he was allotted aforementioned work for total amount of Rs.86,28,817/-, followed by execution of agreement (*Annexure II to writ petition*). On completion of work, he submitted final bills to respondent department for an amount of

5. Since petitioner has already served a legal notice upon respondents, it

would be appropriate to dispose of instant writ petition with a direction

to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 17th March 2020

(Annexure III to writ petition) and consider release of the amount whatever

due to petitioner, of course, in strict accordance with rules governing

the field, provided petitioner has fulfilled all the terms and conditions

of the NIT. Let respondents do well to take a decision in the matter

within a period of eight weeks from the date copy of this order along

with complete set of paper book is served upon them by petitioner.
