The petitioner is an accused in connection with Hirodih P.S. Case No. 57 of 2019.

It has been alleged that on returning from the School the informant found her daughter dead. It has been alleged that there was a dispute between the informant and her in-laws for a partition of land. The deceased died due to asphyxia due to hanging as per the Post Mortem report as mentioned in paragraph 27 of the case diary. The witnesses have cast suspicion on the petitioner and the other accused persons on account of the dispute with respect to the partition which was prevailing between both the sides. There does not appear any eye-witness to the occurrence.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Giridih in connection with Hirodih P.S. Case No. 57 of 2019.
