Petitioners are accused in connection with Dumaria P.S. Case No. 16 of 2019 corresponding to G. R. No. 231 of 2019.

It has been alleged that the sister and nephew of the informant were murdered in their own house. Suspicion was cast upon the petitioner and others due to a land dispute. The statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. of the only eye-witness to the occurrence namely, Salma Soren has been recorded from which it appears that so far as the petitioner no. 1 is concerned, she was not present when the incident had taken place and so far as the petitioner no. 2 is concerned, it has been alleged that she was involved in washing the blood stains from the floor. Specific allegation of committing the murder has been attributed to Ratan Tudu and Biju Tudu.

Regard being had to the statement of Salma Soren under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned District & Additional Sessions Judge II, Ghatsila in connection with S. T. No. 468 of 2019 arising out of Dumaria P.S. Case No. 16 of 2019 corresponding to G. R. No. 231 of 2019.
