The petitioner is an accused in connection with Sidhgora P.S. Case No. 168 of 2019.

It has been alleged that the niece of the informant had fallen down in the Bathroom and died. Suspicion has been cast upon the petitioner and others. The petitioner appears to be husband of the deceased. Although, the charge-sheet has been filed under Section 306 I.P.C., but charge has been framed under Section 302 I.P.C. It appears from the Post Mortem Report which finds place at paragraph 39 of the case diary that the cause of death was opined to be Asphyxia due to hanging and some injuries were found on the scalp of the deceased. Statement of the son of the deceased has been recorded at paragraph 11 of the supplementary case diary in which it has been stated that there used to be frequent quarrel between his parents and on the date of occurrence, his father had gone to see the fair when the incident had occurred. The petitioner appears to be in custody since 11.09.2019.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Session Judge VI, Jamshedpur in connection with S. T. No. 499 of 2019 arising out of Sidhgora P.S. Case No. 168 of 2019.
