Heard Mr. K. K. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Vandana Bharti, learned Special P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Mihijam P.S. Case No. 18 of 2018 corresponding to Cyber No. 115 of 2019 (G. R. No. 143 of 2018).

Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected at that stage in B. A. No. 7102 of 2019.

The petitioner has been implicated on the allegation of he being involved in cyber crime. The petitioner is in custody since 28.03.2019. It also appears that the charge has been framed, but till date not a single witness has been examined.

Regard being had to the observation made earlier and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional District Judge I, Jamtara in connection with Mihijam P.S. Case No. 18 of 2018 corresponding to Cyber No. 115 of 2019 (G. R. No. 143 of 2018).
