Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was twice rejected at that stage in B. A. No. 9290 of 2019 and 10935 of 2019.

The petitioner is alleged to be involved in cyber crime. The petitioner is in custody since 17.07.2019.

Regard being had to the period of custody and the observation made earlier, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge I, Jamtara in connection with Jamtara Cyber P.S.
