Heard Mr. Rohan Mazumdar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Lily Sahay, learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No. 345 of 2019.

Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected at that stage in B. A. No. 442 of 2020.

It appears that from the possession of the petitioner, one countrymade pistol and one live cartridge were recovered for which he is in custody since 26.10.2019.

Regard being had to the period of custody and the observation made earlier, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Gumla in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No. 345 of 2019.
