The petitioner is an accused in connection with S. T. No. 266 of 2019 arising out of Borio P.S. Case No. 227 of 2019 corresponding to G. R. No. 254 of 2019.

It appears that the prayer for bail of the petitioner was earlier rejected in B. A. No. 8954 of 2019 at that stage.

The petitioner appears to be in custody since 16.05.2019 and it has been stated that only three witnesses have been examined till date.

Regard being had to the observation made earlier and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge III, Sahibganj in connection with S. T. No. 266 of 2019 arising out of Borio P.S. Case No. 227 of 2019 corresponding to G. R. No. 254 of 2019.
