The defects as pointed out by the office are ignored.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Pakur (T) P.S. Case No. 1 of 2020.

There was a dispute regarding the landed property purchased by the employer of the informant. There had been altercation and abuses between both the sides. It has been alleged that the accused persons had also taken away the articles kept in the tractor show-room.

Admittedly, there is land dispute between the parties as petitioner nos. 3 to 5 claim the land to be their ancestral land. The FIR also indicates the cases going on between the parties under Sections 107 and 144 of Cr.P.C. The false implication of the petitioners therefore cannot be ruled out.

In view of the background facts of the case, this application stands allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioners above named are directed to surrender in the court below within four weeks and pray for bail, and in that event, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Pakur in connection with Pakur (T)
