Although learned A.P.P. has stated that the petitioner has got criminal antecedents but considering the nature of involvement of the petitioner apart from the fact that he is in custody since 21.11.2019, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only), with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, at Ranchi in connection with Lalpur P.S. Case No. 189 of 2019.
