Defect Nos. 9 (i) to (iv), as pointed out by the office, are ignored. So far as rest defects are concerned, learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the same once the situation normalizes.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Giridih Cyber Crime P.S. Case No. 36 of 2019.

The petitioner and others were apprehended and SIM, Mobiles, Pan Cards etc. were recovered. He was suspected to be involved in cyber crime.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 15.11.2019.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only), with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District Judge-II cum Special Judge, Cyber Case, Giridih in connection with Giridih Cyber Crime P.S. Case No. 36 of 2019, subject to the condition that one of the bailers should be a close relative of the petitioner.
