Defects as pointed out by the office are ignored.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with S. T. No. 374 of 2015 (A) arising out of Pirtand P.S. Case No. 32 of 2012 corresponding to G. R. No. 1194 of 2012.

It appears that the brother of the informant was residing as a Ghar Jamai along with his wife. His brother had also kept another women as second wife. It has been alleged that the brother of the informant had gone to jail in a case and after his release, he started living at his native place. On 25.05.2012, brother of the informant had gone to the in-laws place, but did not return and after a hectic search, his dead body was recovered. The petitioner is the son of the second wife of the deceased. The parents-in-law of the deceased have been granted bail by this Court in B. A. No. 7942 of 2015. The petitioner therefore seems to have been implicated only on suspicion.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned District & Additional Sessions Judge VII, Giridih in connection with S. T. No. 374 of 2015 (A) arising out of Pirtand P.S. Case No. 32 of 2012 corresponding to G. R. No. 1194 of 2012.
