02/31.07.2020: The lawyers have no objection with regard to the proceeding, which has been held through video conferencing today at 11:00 A.M. They have no complaint in respect of the audio and video clarity and quality.

Heard the counsel for the parties.

The petitioners are accused for the offence punishable under Section(s) 411 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

From the impugned order, it is apparent that the name of the petitioners transpired on the confessional statement of co-accused. The petitioners have surrendered on 13.3.2020, which shows that the petitioners were not apprehended from the spot. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners.

Learned A.P.P opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

In view of the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to release the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Gumla in connection with Gurdari PS. Case No. 04/2020, subject to condition that one of bailors should be their close relative.
