02/27.11.2020 Heard Ms. Jasvinder Mazumdar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Prabhu Dayal Agrawal, learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail, as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Mirzachouki P. S. Case No. 53 of 2020.

It has been alleged that the police on raid had found illegal storage of sand. Although the petitioner is not named in the First Information Report but subsequently his name has come up in course of investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent.

On consideration of the fact that the implication of the petitioner is on the basis of suspicion, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner, named above, is directed to surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from today and on such surrender, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sahibganj in connection with Mirzachouki P. S. Case No. 53 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This application stands allowed.
