Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects pointed out by the stamp reporter within two weeks after the lockdown is over.

In view of personal undertaking given by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the defects pointed out by the stamp reporter are ignored for the present.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Tisri P.S. Case No.50 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. No.1128 of 2020 registered under Sections 147/148/149/341/323/324/307 of the Indian Penal Code and subsequently Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was added to the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner murdered Ramdhani Yadav. It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false and general and omnibus in nature. It is next submitted that the main allegation of assault is against Rami Mahto and Mahesh Yadav. It is also submitted that initially the case was registered inter alia for the offences punishable under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code but later on the offence punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was added. It is next submitted that the co-accused with similar allegations has also been released on bail. It is then submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.06.2020 which is evident from para-1 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Giridih in connection with Tisri P.S. Case No.50 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. No.1128 of 2020 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case.
