All these applications are being disposed of by this common order.

Petitioners are accused in connection with Nimdihi P.S. Case No. 46 of 2019.

It has been alleged that a dacoity was committed in the house of the informant. It has been alleged that the wife of the informant was mercilessly assaulted and the informant was also hit on the head by a pistol. It has been alleged that cash of Rs. 70,000/-, ornaments and documents were taken by the dacoits.

It appears that the implication of the petitioner seems to be on account of self-confession as well as on the confession of other accused persons. Paragraph 129 of the case diary contains the confessional statement of accused - Sukdev Kalindi in B. A. No. 773 of 2020 and consequent to the said confession, the others have been implicated who have also rendered their confession.

Mr. Ashok Kumar, learned A.P.P. has stated that there is only confession, so far as the involvement of the petitioners is concerned. There does not appear that any TIP was held nor any recovery was made from the conscious possession of the petitioners, so far as the looted articles are concerned.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Seraikella in connection with Nimdih P.S. Case No. 46 of 2019.
