Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This writ petition has been filed alleging that the direction of the Odisha Administrative Tribunal issued in O.A.No.1612 (C) of 2011 has not been worked out by the opposite parties as of now.

Considering the submissions made, this Court observes that instead of issuing notice, it would be appropriate to give one more opportunity to the opposite parties to comply the direction of the Tribunal vide Annexure-5. In the process, while disposing this writ petition, this Court directs the opposite parties, in the event there is no stay operating order at Annexure-5 by Higher Forum, to work out the direction issued by the Odisha Administrative Tribunal in O.A.No. 1612 (C) of 2011 keeping in view the development through Annexure-6 within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of certified copy of this order by the petitioner, failing which, a suo motu contempt proceeding will be initiated against the opposite parties.

Issue urgent certified copy of this order on proper application.

A free copy of this order be handed over to the learned counsel for the State for compliance.
