3. 29.04.2020

Heard Mr.S.Pattnaik, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Rajani Ch. Mohanty, learned counsel appearing for opposite parties 1 to 3. Mr.Mohanty submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of opposite party No.4 also.

Petitioner, in this writ petition seeks indulgence of this Court and prays for a direction to award her additional weightage in his favour for taking admission as in-service doctors in PG (Medical) Courses, 2020-21.

Mr.Mohanty, learned counsel for opposite party Nos. 1 to 4 files an affidavit in Court and submits that taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is entitled to get additional weightage as prayed for during the current session.

Accordingly, in view of the concession and submission of Mr.R.C.Mohanty, learned counsel for opposite parties 1 to 4, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the opposite party-authorities shall do the needful by awarding additional weightage in favour of the petitioner for the counseling in NEET-PG Medical 2020-21 for taking admission as in-service doctors in PG (Medical) Courses, 2020-21.
