Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that challenging the e-auction sale notice issued by the opposite parties, the petitioner has moved the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Cuttack in S.A. No. 50 of 2020. However in the prevailing unprecedented situation she is not able to get any order from the Tribunal. According to learned counsel the e-auction was held on 26.02.2020 and the sale certificate was also issued. Thus the petitioner is at the verge of eviction.

In view of the above, we dispose of the writ petition giving two months' time to the petitioner to approach the Tribunal to obtain any order in S.A. No. 50 of 2020. For a period of two months from today, status quo as on date, in respect of the mortgaged property shall be maintained by the parties.

The petitioner is at liberty to communicate the order to the opposite parties through e-mail.
