By way of this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of the case records in O.A. No.1387 of 2017 from the office of Odisha Administrative Tribunal, Bhubaneswar to this Court.

Considering the submission made, the prayer is allowed.

The petitioner is permitted to move an application before the Registry of the Tribunal along with copy of this order for transfer of the case records in O.A. No.1387 of 2017 to the High Court. In that event, if an application is moved for transfer of the aforesaid O.A. No.1387 of 2017, the same will be transferred expeditiously.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
