In the wake of the pandemic Covid-19, the case is taken up through V.C.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner being in custody in G.R.Case No.898 of 2020, arising out of Angul P.S. Case No.570 of 2020 pending in the court of S.D.J.M., Angul, has filed this petition for his release on bail. The offences alleged against the petitioner are punishable under Sections 452/341/294/354/ 506/376(1)323/34 of the I.P.C.

During course of hearing, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that since in the meantime the investigation has been completed and charge-sheet has already been filed, the petitioner wants to withdraw this bail application with liberty to approach the concerned Sessions Judge once again.

In view of the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this BLAPL stands dismissed being withdrawn with the liberty sought for.

It is made clear that this Court having not disposed of this bail application on merit, this order of withdrawal, therefore, should not be construed as an expression of any opinion on merit of the bail petition to be filed before the Sessions Judge concerned in any manner and the said Court, therefore, is at liberty to decide the same in its own merit.
