This is the second journey of the petitioner by filing this application under section 439, Cr.P.C. in connection with Baipariguda P.S. Case No.110 of 2017 corresponding to T.R. Case No.48 of 2018 pending trial in the Court of the learned Dist. And Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Koraput at Jeypore for offence punishable under sections 20(b)(ii)(C) of NDPS Act for his release on bail.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State and on going through the materials available on record as also the role said to have been played by the petitioner and other surrounding circumstances, as those emanates from the materials on record, I am not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail to the petitioner.

However, it is observed that the trial court would do well to take all such effective steps for early conclusion of the trial as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
