- 1. This is second bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. The earlier bail application was dismissed as withdrawn on 10/01/2019.
- 2. The applicant has preferred this application for grant of bail as he is arrested in connection with Crime No. 78/2015 registered in Police Station Dalli Rajhara, District Balod (C.G.). for offence punishable under sections 420, 34 of IPC, 1860, Section 3, 4, 5 of Prize Chits and Money Circulation Scheme (Banning) Act, 1978 and 58-F of Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is in jail since 27/01/2016, he has undergone custody for more than 4 years. He submits that out of 40 witnesses 3 witnesses have been examined. It is stated that likewise other co-accused Vandana Balasaheb Bhapkar have been released on bail on 20/12/2019 vide M.Cr.C. No.8037/2019, therefore the applicant may be released on bail.
- 4. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of bail,

however it is not disputed that few of the witnesses have been examined out of 40 witnesses.

- 5. Considering the fact that the applicant is in jail since 27/01/2016, four years have passed and only three witnesses have been examined, taking into pre-trial detention of the applicant, without any observation on the merit, this court is inclined to release the applicant on bail.
- 6. Accordingly, the second bail application is allowed and it is directed that the applicant shall be released on his furnishing personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of concerned trial court for his regular appearance before it as and when directed.
