This is the second application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C for grant of bail in connection with Crime No.214/2018, registered at Police Station–Ratangarh, District- Neemuch for commission of offence punishable under Sections 8/15/29 of the N.D.P.S The applicant is in jail since 5.6.2020. Earlier bail application was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 30.7.2020 passed in M.Cr.C.No.20908/2020.

There is ample evidence available on record, which directly connect the applicant with the alleged crime. Learned counsel for the applicant fails to point out any change in circumstances and, therefore, no case is made out for grant of bail. Thus, this repeat bail application is **dismissed** as being without merit.
