

The High Court Of Madhya Pradesh**WP-15546-2020***(HEMANT SINGH KORI Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH AND OTHERS)***Jabalpur, Dated : 23-10-2020****Heard through Video Conferencing.**

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner, who is posted as Sub Engineer, (Contractual), Janpad Panchyat Prithvipur, district Niwadi, M.P. challenging the order of transfer dated 28.07.2020 (Ann. P-4) and order dated 29.9.2020, (Ann. P-6) passed by the respondent No.2 and respondent no. 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the impugned transfer order although the petitioner has submitted a representation to the respondent on 01.10.2020 (Annexure P/7) but the same is still pending.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to submit a fresh representation alongwith all the relevant documents before the respondent concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on receipt of such representation, the same shall be decided by the respondent concerned in accordance with law within a further period of six weeks therefrom, by a reasoned and speaking order.

Till the petitioner's representation is decided, the status quo shall be maintained as it exists today.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
