

The High Court Of Madhya Pradesh**MCRC-43866-2020***(ANKIT SINGH PARIHAR Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH)***Jabalpur, Dated : 27-11-2020****Heard through Video Conferencing.**

This is first bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of bail to the applicant. Applicant has been arrested on 20.10.2020 in connection with Crime No.550/2020 registered at Police Station Churhat, District Sidhi (M.P.) for commission of offence punishable under Sections 34(2) of Excise Act.

It is submitted by the counsel appearing for the applicant that applicant is innocent and he is falsely being implicated in the case by the police. On this ground, he prayed that applicant may be released on bail.

Counsel appearing for the State Government opposed the application for grant of bail and submitted that applicant has criminal antecedents and other offences of similar nature have been registered against him at Crime Nos.381/2020 and 365/2019 and both the offences are under Excise Act.

Since the applicant is repeatedly committing similar offences after being released on bail and he has also breached the conditions of bail bond, therefore, application filed by the applicant is **rejected**.
