PER COURT:-

1. Mr. Deshmukh, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order of suspension is *per se* and *ex-facie* illegal. It does not stand to any reason. The righteous act of the petitioner cannot be a ground for suspension. According to the learned counsel the order of suspension is illegal.

2. The suspension of the petitioner is pending enquiry. The order of suspension is not by way of penalty. Three months have lapsed. At this stage, we are not inclined to entertain the petition qua the order of suspension. Even otherwise, after six months of the order of suspension, the petitioner can move the authorities seeking review of the order of suspension.

3. With the aforesaid observations, writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
