The present writ petition is filed on behalf of Life Insurance Corporation

of India, against the award, dated 29.11.2019 passed in P.L.A.No.401 of 2019

by learned Permanent Lok Adalat for Public Utility Services, Krishna at

Machilipatnam. By the said award, learned Permanent Lok Adalat for Public

Utility Services allowed the said P.L.A. directing Life Insurance Corporation of

India to pay an amount of Rs.50,000/-, which is covered by insurance policy

and further directed to pay Rs.2,000/- as costs. Learned counsel for the

petitioners/insurance company tried to persuade the Court that the award is

not in accordance with law.

Without going into merits of the case, considering the fact that the

amount, which was directed to be paid was only Rs.50,000/-, the Court is of

the opinion that there is no reason for interfering with the matter.

4. In view of the above, the Writ Petition stands dismissed. There shall

be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand

closed.
