THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURESH REDDY WRIT PETITION No.22315 of 2020

ORDER: (Per Honourable Sri Justice A.V.Sesha Sai)

Heard Sri K.Viswanatham, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Sri G.L.Nageswara Rao, learned Government Pleader for Stamps & Registration, apart from perusing the entire material available on record.

Earlier, when the petitioner herein approached this Court, by way of filing W.P.No.7802 of 2016, questioning the sale of certain properties, under the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002, this Court allowed the said Writ Petition by way of an order, dated 22.08.2016. In the said order, while setting aside the *e*-auction sale notice, dated 10.02.2016, published in the Newspaper, dated 13.02.2016, this Court directed marking of the order to the District Registrar, Kurnool for effecting necessary cancellation and changes in his records in terms of Section 31 (2) of the Specific Relief Act, 1963.

According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, subsequently, a legal notice was also got issued by the petitioner herein to the respondents 1 and 2. It is also submitted that on 05.10.2020, petitioner herein submitted a representation for redressal of her grievance, but no action has been taken so far on the said representation.

Eventually, a request is made by the learned counsel for the

petitioner to direct the fourth respondent herein to verify the said

representation and to take appropriate action as per law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned Government Pleader and taking into consideration the facts

and circumstances of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of,

directing the District Registrar, Kurnool District-fourth respondent

herein to verify the representation, dated 05.10.2020, said to have

been submitted by the petitioner herein, and take appropriate

action/pass appropriate orders, strictly in accordance with law, as

expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three

months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall

be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending

in the Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
