Business, R/o H.No 6-41,Bachannapet, Jangaon, Warangal District in the cause-title on the file this Honble Court

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HON'BLE Dr. JUSTICE SHAMEEM AKTHER TRANSFER CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS PETITION No.40 of 2020

ORDER:

This Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition, under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, is filed by the petitioner/wife, requesting to withdraw HMOP No.90 of 2019 from the file of Senior Civil Judge, at Jangaon, Warangal, and transfer the same to the file of Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, for trial and disposal along with OP No.236 of 2020, in accordance with law.

- Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/wife and perused the record. There is no representation for the respondent/husband today and also on the last date of occasion.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner/wife submitted that there are two O.Ps i.e, HMOP No.90 of 2019 and OP No.236 of 2020. HMOP No.90 of 2019 is filed by the respondent/husband under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, before the Senior Civil Judge, at Jangaon, Warangal, seeking dissolution of marriage, whereas O.P.No.236 of 2020 is filed by the petitioner/wife under Section 9 of H.M.Act before the Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, seeking restitution of conjugal rights. It is submitted that to have consistency and to avoid conflicting orders and also for better understanding of the lis, both the OPs are required to be disposed of by one Court and ultimately prayed to withdraw HMOP No.90 of 2019 from the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Jangaon, Warengal, and transfer the same to the file of

Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, for trial and disposal along with O.P.No.236 of 2020.

- As seen from the material placed on record, HMOP No.90 of 4. 2019 is filed by the respondent/husband under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, before the Senior Civil Judge, at Jangaon, Warangal, seeking divorce, whereas O.P.No.236 of 2020 is filed by the petitioner/wife under Section 9 of H.M.Act before the Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, seeking restitution of conjugal rights. It is relevant to state that Section 19 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been amended in the year 2003, by insertion of proviso (iii)(a). The amended Section 19(iii)(a) of the Act gives special preference to the wife to file a petition and prosecute the same, before the Court within whose jurisdiction she resides. Law is well settled that in the cases of this nature, convenience of the wife is of paramount importance. The petitioner/wife is residing at Hyderabad and certainly, her attendance before the Court at Warangal causes inconvenience to her. She has to travel from Hyderabad to Warangal, i.e., around 150 kilometres. Though small inconvenience may be caused to the respondent/husband in attending the Court at Hyderabad, the convenience of the wife should be preferred and shall prevail over the inconvenience, if any, which may be caused to the husband.
- 5. In the given circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate if HMOP No.90 of 2019 filed by the respondent/husband before the Senior Civil Judge, Jangaon, Warangal, is withdrawn and transferred to the file of Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, to avoid inconsistency and conflicting decisions and for

better understanding of the lis and also to save the valuable time of the Court.

In the result, this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed and HMOP No.90 of 2019 is withdrawn from the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Jangaon, Warangal, and transferred to the file of Judge, Family Court, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, for trial and disposal, in accordance with law. If the Court chooses to club both the OPs i.e, HMOP No.90 of 2019 and OP No.236 of 2020, it can do 50.
