Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction, one or more particularly in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of 2nd Respondent in not cancelling the sale and in not returning the sale certificate amount of Rs.52,50,000/-, in relation to the E-Auction conducted on 15.05.2019, with regard to the property situated in Sy. No.271 and 274 total admeasuring 360.61 Sq. Yards, situated at Ward No.1, Block No.6, Road No.3, Vidyanagar, Suryapet, Nalgonda District, as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, apart from being contrary to the provisions of SARFAESI Act and consequently directing the Respondents to return the sale certificate amount of Rs.52,50,000/- along with interest @ 24% per annum

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
