Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased stay all further proceedings in FIR No. 62 of 2020 dated 16.01.2020 before the Station House Officer, Madhapur Police Station, Cyberabad, R R District, including investigation and arrest of the petition pending disposal of Quash Petition

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Damodar Mundra, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor, on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and of the Respondent No.2 not appearing in person or by Advocate.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HON'BLE JUSTICE G.SRI DEVI CRIMINAL PETITION No.2012 of 2020

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner/Accused No.2 secking to quash the proceedings against her in Crime No.62 of 2020 of Madhapur (Guttala) Police Station, Cyberabad District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 447, 427, 506 and 120-B read with 34 LP.C.

- Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused No.2,
 the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the
 1st respondent-State and perused the record.
- 3. Though the learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused No.2 filed the present petition for quashing the investigation in the aforesaid crime, he restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the Investigating agency to follow the procedure prescribed under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and follow the guidelines prescribed by the Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar and another.
- 4. Under these circumstances, the Station House Officer, Madhapur (Guttala) Police Station, Cyberabad District, is directed to follow the procedure laid down under Section 41 A Cr.P.C. before arresting the petitioner/Accused No.2 and strictly adhere to the guidelines formulated by the Apex Court in Arnesh Kumar case (supra). However, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner/accused No.2 till filling of the final report.
